ORDER

The University vide U.O. read (1) above (Appendix I – Sl.No.9) had sanctioned an amount of ₹70,500/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand and Five Hundred only) for the Guest Faculty engagement during the period July-November 2017 for Department of Instrumentation. The Head, Department of Instrumentation vide reference cited (2) above has informed that they had requested for an amount of ₹10,50,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) towards the remuneration of Guest Faculty engaged for the period July-November 2017.

After considering the request and recommendations of the committee constituted to study the Guest Faculty requirements of various Departments/Schools, the Vice-Chancellor has accorded sanction for the following;


- To cancel Sl.No.9 (Department of Instrumentation) of Appendix I in U.O. read (1) above.
- For the payment of remuneration to Guest Faculty of Department of Instrumentation as give below;

The Guest Faculty engaged will be eligible for remuneration as per the rules existing in the University. However, Research Fellows who are in receipt of any funding from agencies like CSIR, UGC etc., if engaged, will not be eligible for any remuneration. Also any staff of the University engaged, shall be paid remuneration in accordance with Section 48 of KSR Part I. The Head, Department of Instrumentation may certify these conditions. Practical and Theory classes are to be shown separately while submitting the bill. The Head, Department of Instrumentation is to ensure strict compliance of UGC norms with respect to teaching hours of the permanent faculty and also the rules regarding payment of remuneration to Guest Faculty.

The expenditure in this regard shall be met from the Head of Account as noted against the Department.

The U.O. read (1) above stands modified to this extent only.
